Following the Great Kanto Earthquake in 1923, some streets with tram lines were rebuilt on slightly different, generally straighter alignments. Some tram lines were rebuilt on different streets (e.g. Route 12). These changes are indicated where significant. 'n' before consonants often shown as 'm' as pronounced (e.g. 'nm' as 'mm'). 'n' is the more correct, but both versions appear erratically in timetables, maps (e.g. the Tokyo Area Rail Map shows 'm') and on station nameboards.
