Not included: most funiculars & cliff rlys, people-movers & miniature rlys; station name "for" and county suffixes; stops for rail staff at signal boxes and similar (but included if also used by wives & family); temporary platforms for depot open days & one day events for invited attendees only; ticket platforms (at which tickets were inspected) unless evidence found of official use by alighting or boarding passengers; railway enthusiasts excursions
