HOUSTON TERMINAL STATIONS/DEPOTS:

The history of central Houston terminal stations appears to be very complex. It would seem from Official Guide indices that some of the RR companies occasionally relocated from one depot to another prior to opening of Union Depot. Only the MKT, Amtrak & Union Stations are shown on the SPV Atlas

DALLAS TERMINAL STATIONS/DEPOTS

Map TX 24 in the SPV RR Atlas will help understand the complexities in Dallas, although most of the early depots and some of the original RR routes are not shown.

The first railroad into Dallas, the Texas & Pacific (TP), ran east to west along Pacific Street (most of which is the current DART route) and established its depot at Pacific & Lamar Sts, close to the present West End DART stop. The second RR, Houston & Texas Central (HTC) ran north to south along what is now Central Expressway (and approximately the DART route from Mockingbird to near Pearl stop). Its depot was at the crossing with the TP. (Both this depot and the original route southeast to Trinity Jn is not shown on SPV map). The TP initially kept its main depot at Pacific/Lamar, but also stopped at the crossing, calling this location H.T.& C. Crossing. By 1885, TP and HTC had built a joint Union Depot at this crossing – the original TP depot being renamed Dallas City Depot. Other RRs soon followed the HTC: Santa Fe, MKT, St Louis SW, Texas Trunk, all with their own terminal depots.

The early railroads laid most of the tracks along what soon became major streets as Dallas developed from a minor community to a major city. In 1911, the City published the Kessler Plan to remove most tracks from the City streets by construction of a Belt Line around the east and south sides of the City and provision of the current Union Station, opened in 1916. Most of the original termini closed at this time, but the TP continued to use the Pacific Avenue route, backing into the new Union Station, until opening of the Belt Line in 1920 (the current Amtrak route). The original Union Depot was renamed East Dallas to avoid confusion with the new Terminal.
